## VERTICAL CHURCH

We are studying the first church in the book of Acts, and we are working through Church Renewal during our seven weeks of prayer. In Acts 2, the church of Jesus Christ began on the Day of Pentecost. The main topic at this church was the wonderful "Vertical God" whose glory is best seen in the saving work of His Son, Jesus Christ, as His believers met together (horizontally).
